

Partners for Clean Streams Invites you to Host a Fishing Line Recycling Bin

Dear Valued Community Member,

Partners for Clean Streams would like to invite you to join our efforts to clean our rivers and streams, to make them enjoyable for all. Our "Adopt-a-Bin" program encourages organizations and property owners to work together to host and maintain Fishing Line Recycling Bins in high-traffic fishing areas around the greater Toledo area. We have several Fishing Line Recycling Bins made out of PVC pipe and provide organizations, like yours, the opportunity to host one. Local groups are assigned to each of the recycling bins and are be responsible for collecting the line and emptying the bins regularly, if your organization chooses not to. Providing access to recycling bins encourages anglers to properly dispose of their fishing line, and therefore decrease entanglement of animals, increase aesthetics, and improve recreation along the river.

Due to your property (or properties) having access for fishing, we are inviting you to host one or more Fishing Line Recycling Bins at your park, store, marina, or other location. Your organization or business will only be accountable for the installation of the recycling bin, although you are welcome to be responsible for collecting the line as well. Other than installation materials, there are no additional costs to you for hosting the recycling bin, unless you choose to sponsor the bin.

Each bin comes complete with educational signage instructions and the contact information of the organization responsible for collecting the line. The collected fishing line is sorted and then recycled by Berkley Fishing, which turns it into commercial fish habitat structures.
